


Our district has been left behind by the state...


Our community has been left with the responsibility to fund the programs that make our district excellent.

First New Fund Request Since 2004!

Income NOT Taxed: social security benefits; disability and survivors benefits; railroad retirement benefits; welfare benefits; child support; property received as a gift, bequest or inheritance; workers' compensation benefits; interest; dividends; and unemployment compensation.

Income that IS taxed: earned income and self-employment income.
